Solutions

1. Answer: A

Explanation: Speed = 72 km/hr = $72 \times (5/18) = 20$ m/s. Length of train = distance to cross man = $20 \times 18 = 360$ m. Distance to cross platform = length of train + length of platform = $20 \times 30 = 600$ m. Length of platform = $600 - 360 = 240$ m.

2. Answer: B

Explanation: Let present ages be $7x$ and $3x$. After 5 years: $(7x + 5)/(3x + 5) = 2/1$. $7x + 5 = 6x + 10 \Rightarrow x = 5$. Mother's present age = $7x = 7 \times 5 = 35$ years.

3. Answer: 29.16 liters

Explanation: Formula: Final quantity = Initial quantity $\times (1 - \text{replaced quantity}/\text{total volume})^n$. Final milk = $40 \times (1 - 4/40)^3 = 40 \times (9/10)^3 = 40 \times (729/1000) = 29.16$ liters.

4. Answer: D

Explanation: Interest for the 3rd year = $3149.28 - 2916 = 233.28$. Rate of interest $R = (233.28/2916) \times 100 = 8\%$. Sum $P = A/(1 + R/100)^2 = 2916/(1.08)^2 = 2916/1.1664 = 2500$.

5. Answer: B

Explanation: Let the work last for x days. A worked for 6 days, B worked for $(x - 6)$ days, and C worked for x days. $(6/24) + (x - 6)/32 + (x/64) = 1$. Multiply by 64: $16 + 2(x - 6) + x = 64 \Rightarrow 16 + 2x - 12 + x = 64 \Rightarrow 3x + 4 = 64 \Rightarrow 3x = 60 \Rightarrow x = 20$ days.

6. Answer: C

Explanation: Part filled by A and B in 4 mins = $4 \times (1/15 + 1/20) = 4 \times (7/60) = 7/15$. Remaining part = $1 - 7/15 = 8/15$. Time taken by B to fill the rest = $(8/15) \times 20 = 32/3$ mins = 10 mins 40 sec. Total time = 4 mins + 10 mins 40 sec = 14 mins 40 sec.

7. Answer: C

Explanation: Let rate of stream be y km/hr. Speed upstream = $15 - y$, speed downstream = $15 + y$. Time up = $2 \times$ Time down $\Rightarrow D/(15 - y) = 2 \times D/(15 + y) \Rightarrow 15 + y = 30 - 2y \Rightarrow 3y = 15 \Rightarrow y = 5$ km/hr.

8. Answer: A

Explanation: LCM of 3, 5, 8, 12 is 120. Greatest 5-digit number is 99999. $99999 \div 120$ gives remainder 39. Greatest 5-digit number exactly divisible = $99999 - 39 = 99960$. Required number = $99960 + 2 = 99962$.

9. Answer: B

Explanation: Let CP of 1 article be 1. CP of 15 articles = 15. SP of 15 articles = CP of 20 articles = 20. Profit = $20 - 15 = 5$. Profit % = $(5/15) \times 100 = 33.33\%$.

10. Answer: C

Explanation: Selling Price = $500 \times (1 - 0.20) \times (1 - 0.10) = 500 \times 0.8 \times 0.9 = 500 \times 0.72 = 360$.

11. Answer: B
