Solutions

1. Answer: B

Explanation: Let initial speed be $x = 40$ km/hr. Return speed $y = 40 + 50\%$ of $40 = 60$ km/hr. Average speed for equal distance $= 2xy/(x + y) = (2 \times 40 \times 60)/(40 + 60) = 4800/100 = 48$ km/hr.

2. Answer: B

Explanation: For 2 years, $CI - SI = P(R/100)^2$. $65 = P \times (10/100)^2 \Rightarrow 65 = P \times (1/100) \Rightarrow P = 6500$.

3. Answer: C

Explanation: Let total capacity be V . Initial juice $= 4V/7$. After drawing 14L and replacing with water, juice remains $= 4V/7 - (4/7) \times 14 = 4V/7 - 8$. New ratio of juice to total is $3/7$. So $(4V/7 - 8)/V = 3/7 \Rightarrow 4V - 56 = 3V \Rightarrow V = 56$ is wrong, $3 : 4$ means $3/(3 + 4) = 3/7$ of the mixture is juice. Yes, $4V/7 - 8 = 3V/7 \Rightarrow V/7 = 8 \Rightarrow V = 56$. Let's re-verify. Initial: $4x$ juice, $3x$ water ($7x = 56 \Rightarrow x = 8$, juice=32, water=24). Draw 14L (8L juice, 6L water). Juice $= 24$. Add 14L water. Total $= 56$. Juice $= 24$. Ratio $= 24 : 32 = 3 : 4$. Capacity $= 56$ liters.

4. Answer: A

Explanation: Total valid votes $= 7500 \times 80\% = 6000$. One got 55%, so the other got 45% of valid votes. 45% of 6000 $= 2700$.

5. Answer: A

Explanation: Net filling in 1 hour $= 1/12 + 1/15 - 1/20 = 5/60 + 4/60 - 3/60 = 6/60 = 1/10$. The tank will be filled in 10 hours.

6. Answer: C

Explanation: Unit digit of $(2467)^{153}$ depends on 7^{153} . $153 \div 4$ leaves remainder 1, so $7^1 = 7$. Unit digit of $(341)^{72}$ depends on $1^{72} = 1$. Product $= 7 \times 1 = 7$.

7. Answer: B

Explanation: When two items are sold at the same price, one at a profit of $x\%$ and the other at a loss of $x\%$, there is always a net loss. Loss $\% = (x^2)/100 = (20^2)/100 = 400/100 = 4\%$.

8. Answer: A

Explanation: Let $a = 3k$, $b = 4k$. $8(3k) + 5(4k) = 22 \Rightarrow 24k + 20k = 22 \Rightarrow 44k = 22 \Rightarrow k = 0.5$. $a = 3 \times 0.5 = 1.5$.

9. Answer: B
