Section A

- 1 (A) **Technology** — “Technology” is an authentic lexical English entry denoting engineering systems. Alternate combinations are arbitrary pseudowords.
- 2 (B) **Communication** — “Communication” is a valid English noun mapping structural data exchange parameters.
- 3 (B) **Digital** — “Digital” is an official English entry adjective referencing computerized systems.
- 4 (A) **Resource** — “Resource” stands as the unique real English word node in this choice selection set.
- 5 (A) **Innovation** — “Innovation” is a legitimate vocabulary noun tracking progressive structural changes.
- 6 (B) **Platform** — “Platform” is an established vocabulary noun tracking runtime software layout frameworks.
- 7 (A) **Education** — “Education” represents standard morphological formatting patterns.
- 8 (A) **Networking** — “Networking” is a structural English progressive noun tracking connection layers.
